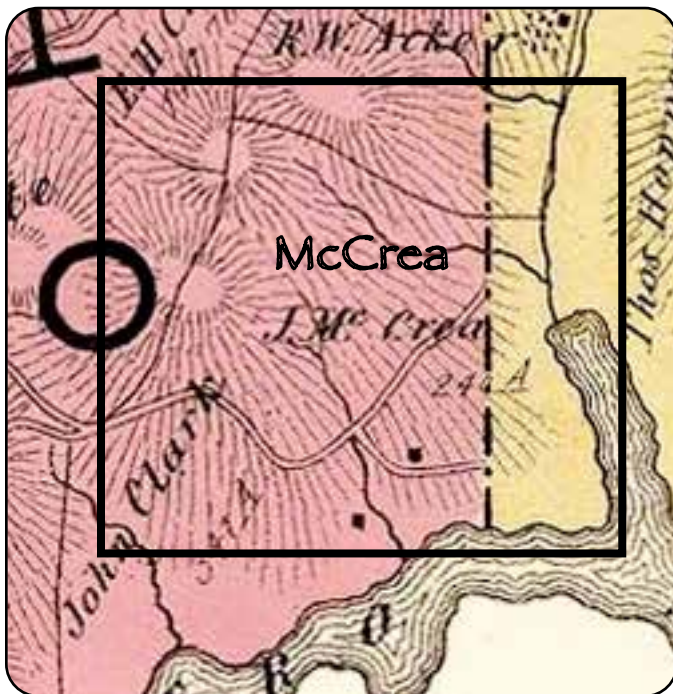

DIED SUDDENLY AT BODEGA

Mrs. Margarite McCrea Roe died suddenly at 11 o'clock today at her home in Bodega. She was the widow of the late Mr. McCrea of Bodega and wife of William S. Roe. She was a pioneer of northwestern Sonoma county. Mrs. Roe was the mother of Mrs. Annie Strong of Bennett Valley and Walter McCrea of San Francisco and a niece of Mr. and Mrs. Robert Gordon of Petaluma.

She was a native of Ireland aged fifty eight years but had spent most of her life at Bodega. Deceased was very well known among the pioneers of this section.

The interment will be in the Bloomfield cemetery. She had many friends in Petaluma to whom her sudden death will bring sorrow.

Margaret Lemon Menary

When Margaret Lemon Menary was born on June 20, 1853, in Armagh, Armagh, Northern Ireland, her father, John, was 35, and her mother, Ann, was 27. She married John McCrea and they had three children together. She then married William Sherwood Roe in June 1905. She died on February 9, 1910, in Bodega, California, at the age of 56, and was buried in Bloomfield, California.

McCrea, John W. Born in the north of Ireland in the year 1831, and there received his early education. At the age of seventeen years he paid a three-years' visit to Scotland, at the end of which he emigrated to America. After residing for nearly three years in Connecticut Mr. McCrea came to California, by way of Panama, and arrived at San Francisco, April 2, 1854. Here, for six months, he was employed in a brick-yard, and afterwards, for a short time, as a day laborer in Marin county, and at the expiration of which he proceeded to and settled in Sonoma county. In May, 1872, he left for a visit to the "Old Country," returning in September, 1875. He now resides in Bodega, having retired from business. Mr. McCrea married April 6, 1876, Maggie L. Menary, a native of Ireland, by whom he has two children, Annie Bella and John Wesley.

Well-Known Pioneer Gone.

The news of the death of Mr. John McCrea, the well known and highly respected pioneer, which occurred at his residence at Bodega Thursday afternoon at 3 o'clock was received here with much regret by his many friends. He was about eighty years of age and was a native of Ireland.

Many years ago Mr. McCrea moved to Bodega, where he owned considerable property and has always been recognized as one of the most substantial citizens of western Sonoma, says the Press-Democrat.

Deceased leaves a widow, a daughter, Miss Anne McCrea, and two sons, Wesley and Walter McCrea. A brother also survives him.

The funeral will take place Sunday morning at half past 10 o'clock from the church at Bodega.

Deceased had many friends here where he frequently visited.
